Student Activities

- Create a list of characteristics of a good friend
- Invite a friend over for a game night
- Make a list of nonverbal communication skills you need to work on-pick 1 to improve
- Write an email to a friend or teacher giving them a compliment
- Attend a social event at school or in the community
- Demonstrate how to get someone's attention without interrupting
- Practice a natural smile/pose for pictures- send us a picture
- List someone you view as a role model and tell why

Family-Style Concept Practice

- Have a family joke telling night-discuss appropriate humor
- Have your child invite a friend over for a playdate/meal-talk about how it went
- Evaluate your child's table habits/meal skills
- Create a family text group and use/model appropriate pleasantries
- Discuss private versus public behaviors
- Discuss internet safety in regards to social media
- Have a family game night and talk about ways to be a good sport when losing
- Talk to your child about a time they felt left out-what could they change for next time?
