

# ECC@Home Challenge: Compensatory Skills

## Student Activities

- Create a document that describes how you access print materials
- Organize your computer folders or binder by subjects
- Practice to increase your typing speed/accuracy
- Have a teacher or peer evaluate your note-taking skills
- Evaluate an image description
- Estimate how long it will take you to do something and time yourself to see if you were correct
- Select manipulatives to use for a math or science concept and explain why these were chosen
- Estimate the size of a room in your house and measure to see how close you were

## Family-Style Concept Practice

- Have your child teach the family how to use one of their low vision tools
- Watch a Youtube video on the abacus and solve a simple math problem together
- Take a typing test and see who can type the fastest in the family
- Have your child sort and put away silverware
- Have your child repeat or summarize something you said to them
- Have your child alphabetize your movies or books
- Have your child estimate how long something will need to cook for and compare real time for accuracy
- Have your child estimate the size of an object and compare real results for accuracy
