Family-Style Concept Practice

- Listen to an audiobook and have your child adjust the speed and volume
- Have your child take a family photo-evaluate it
- Discuss the cost of computers/phones/tablets/devices
- Have your child create a family music playlist in an app
- Let your child create an online grocery list or order take out online
- Do an internet search together and evaluate the credibility of a website
- Have your child set up/connect to a blue tooth speaker/device
- Ask your child how they would complete an assignment or task without their technology
